



Daybreak Parent Guidelines

We must receive your confirmation of attendance by the **MONDAY** before Daybreak.

All Daybreak participants must have a completed application and waiver form on file in order to participate.

Please label all of your child's belongings. Parents must supply any necessary supplies, such as sippy cups or diapers. You will need to provide a snack and drink for your child. Please do not send in items with peanuts/tree nuts due to allergies.

Daybreak is first come/first served. Since we are a volunteer run program, there may be times when we fill up and may not be able to accept any more children. There may be times when we do not have enough children signed up for Daybreak. If that happens, we will make every attempt to get your child scheduled for the following Daybreak session.

We cannot accept any children at Daybreak who do not have a confirmed spot. We will email parents by Wednesday to confirm your child's spot. We will send out a reminder email if we have open slots and extra volunteers.

If you must cancel your confirmation, please inform the Daybreak Coordinator at hdecou@verizon.net immediately so that we can offer the space up to another child.

Daybreak runs from 2-5 p.m. We will begin curbside pick-up for your children starting at 4:45. Please arrive to pick up your child by 5 p.m. at the latest as our volunteers must leave at that time.
